

Welcome to the **Rancho Cielo Equestrian Facility** opened in 2016! We are located on the east side of Rancho Santa Fe and are just minutes from the Rancho Santa Fe Village. We are 10 minutes from the Del Mar Race Track where the Surf meets the Turf, Highway 5 and the Ocean.

We are a one of a kind Equestrian Facility that sits on a level 11 acres. The facility has 3 jumping arenas, 1 regulation size dressage arena and 1 western schooling arena. The property is quiet, private and has access to miles of trails throughout picturesque Rancho Santa Fe.

We have multiple barn: a 10 stall with in & outs, another 10 stalls with large tack room, a 20 stall with 2 tack rooms. There are fully covered corrals and we have many partially sheltered corrals ranging in size from 12 \times 24 up to 24 \times 48 for your horses' comfort.

Each property area is services with cross ties, wash racks, tack / feed / tack sheds, lunge rings and turnouts.

All boarding options at the Rancho Cielo Equestrian Facility are listed below. We offer the following boarding with rates beginning at \$725.00 per month:

\$1075 ~ 12' x 12' barn stalls with 12' x 24' in and out, includes shavings, 2x daily cleaning and feeding

\$895 ~ 12' x 12' barn box stall, includes shavings, 2x daily cleaning and feeding

\$895 ~ 12' x 12' Pony barn box stall, includes shavings, 2x daily cleaning and feeding

\$975 ~ 12' x 24' fully covered mare motel (11 Stall Shed row stalls), includes shavings, 2x daily cleaning and feeding

\$895 ~ 12' x 24' fully covered mare motel (14 Stall Mare Motel stalls), includes shavings, 2x daily cleaning and feeding

\$875 ~ 24' x 48' partially covered outside corral, includes 2x daily cleaning and feeding

\$775 ~ 24' x 24' partially covered outside corral, includes 2x daily cleaning and feeding

\$775 ~ 12' x 36' partially covered outside corral, includes 2x daily cleaning and feeding

\$725 ~ 12' x 24' partially covered outside corral, includes 2x daily cleaning and feeding

Barn Rules

- All riders or anyone handling a horse must sign a Release of Liability before riding and/or boarding any horse. Boarders are responsible for having all guests sign releases. The Release of Liability forms are available at the Ranch Office.
- Children 14 and under MUST be supervised by an adult at all times.
- All Boarders, Trainers, Instructors, Students and Staff are required to wear an ASTM approved helmet when mounted on a horse.
- NO SMOKING OR VAPING ANYWHERE ON THE PROPERTY AT ANY TIME.
- Dogs must be leashed, under control and quiet at all times.
- Owners must clean up after their dogs.
- Speed limit of the property is 5 MPH for the safety of everyone. This also includes all paved roads on the property.
- Park in designated spaces only.
- Adhere to the posted 'No Lunging' signs for the specified arenas.
- Do not leave your horse unattended in any area including an arena at any time.
- Please do not give treats to horses other than your own, unless approved by the owner.
- You must clean up after your horse, it is very important for the longevity of the footing that manure be removed from the footing immediately.
- Please clean up the wash racks after you use them.
- Permission must be asked and given to move, change or use a trainers' poles and jumps.
- Adhere to all posted signs throughout the property.
- Please turn off the lights if you are the last person to leave.
- If you unlock it, lock it back up. If you open it, close it. If you borrow it, clean and return it. If you turn it on, turn it off. If you take it out, put it back. If you break it, fix it. If you drop it, pick it up. If you do not know, ask. If it drinks water, give it some.
- Please be considerate and respectful of others.

Rancho Cielo Equestrian Facility Emergency Evacuation Plan

In the event of an evacuation when we have to remove horses from the facility, the following is the standard operating procedure in place:

Karyl Hanley will send direct text messages to each ranch trainer so they can contact their clients then keep them informed. Please keep your cell phone nearby. When there is an evacuation, please do not rely on email since this emergency procedure may not always be available to everyone.

All halters should have a tag with the horse name, the owner name and phone number and trainers name and phone number.

Register your cell phone at www.alertsandiego.org for notification of wildfires, etc., through Reverse 911. Please add the Cal Fire and SD Emergency apps to your cell phones for fast resource information in case of a fire or any other emergency situation.

We will evacuate to the following site based on the situation and direction of the fire:
